## East Haddam Dog Park Rules

- 1. Handler of a dog is responsible for the acts and conduct of the dog while at the Park.
- 2. Park users, dog handlers, and attendants assume all risks associated with the use of the Park.
- 3. Park Hours: Sunrise to Sunset
- 4. Smoking and food consumption is not permitted inside the fenced in Dog Park area.
- 5. Dogs should be neutered or spayed.
- 6. Sick dogs, aggressive dogs and dogs under 6 months of age shall refrain from using the Park.
- 7. Dogs with a known history of aggressive or dangerous behavior shall not use the Park.
- 8. Handler shall have a leash on hand for each dog at all times.
- 9. Dogs shall be attended, within eyesight and under voice control of the handler, at all times.
- 10. Children under 16 years of age shall be supervised by an adult.
- 11. Choke, pronged, spiked and electronic collars shall be removed from the dog prior to entering the Park.
- 12. Handlers shall immediately clean up after their dogs. All waste should be placed in the proper receptacles.
- 13. Handler is responsible for filling holes and repairing damage caused by their dogs.
- 14. Dog treats, bones and chew toys shall not be brought into the Park.
- 15. Pets other than dogs shall not be brought into the Park.
- 16. Handlers are responsible for providing drinking water for their dogs.
- 17. Strollers, bikes, skateboards, roller blades/skates, and any motorized vehicles shall be kept out of the Park, with the exception of wheelchairs.
- 18. Damage, violations and concerns should be directed to East Haddam Parks and Recreation.
- 19. Organized events must have written permission from East Haddam Parks and Recreation.
- 20. This is a substance free park, no alcohol, drugs or tobacco are allowed.
